Letter of Wishes

To my Trustees

Dear Sirs,

In giving my Trustees the fullest powers to administer and manage "The Brown Forbes Memorial Fund" over the years I should like my Trustees to be aware of my wishes for the Fund. I declare however that my wishes are only to assist my Trustees in their deliberations and are not intended to bind them in any way.

- (a) I would prefer that the capital of the fund remain invested and the income used for the Trust purposes.
- (b) I would hope that the Fund would be continued in perpetuity.
- (c) My primary preference would be for the funds to be used in restoring and beautifying areas of the Scottish countryside to which the general public is granted access.
- (d) While I am in favour of some funds being donated from time to time for the renovation of historic buildings and gardens, I should not like this sector to absorb any more than 20% of the funds available at any particular time.
- (e) Where the Trust is participating in a larger project, I should prefer that the Fund was only one of several contributors with other organisations or individuals playing their full part.
- (f) Where the fund has made a meaningful contribution I should like my Trustees to consider some form of commemorative plaque or other permanent acknowledgement to The Brown Forbes Memorial Fund if they deem same to be appropriate.
