AT EDINBURGH the Twelfth day of June Nineteen hundred and ninety eight the Deed hereinafter reproduced was presented for registration in the Books of the Lords of Council and Session for preservation and is registered in the said Books as follows:-

I, MISS JANET ROBERTSON BROWN, Retired, Fifty nine Titwood Road, Glasgow revoke all former Wills and testamentary writings made by me and declare my domicile to be in Scotland. I assign, dispone and bequeath everything of which I shall die possessed real, personal, heritable moveable and otherwise and everything over which I may have power of appointment, apportionment or disposal (herein called "my estate") to Norman Stocks Thomson, Chartered Accountant, Templeton Business Centre, Templeton Street, Glasgow G40 1DL, Thomas Alan Smith, White Gables, Twelve Burnside Road, Whitecraigs, Glasgow, Alan Crombie, Nine Barassie Drive, Bridge of Weir and George Graham Browning, Solicitor, One hundred and Forty two Queen Street, Glasgow as my Trustees and Executors and to the survivor and survivors of them and to the executor of the last survivor and acceptor of my Trustees but in trust only for the following purposes:-

FIRST I direct my Trustees to pay and fulfil all legacies, bequests and other instructions which I may give in writing signed by me although such writing is informally executed or defective.

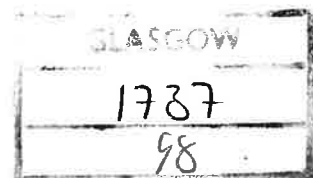
SECOND I direct my Trustees to pay my just and lawful debts, sickbed and funeral expenses.

THIRD I direct my Trustees to pay and make over the following legacies free of duty and without interest as soon as they shall deem it convenient to do so after my death -

(a) To my cousin Miss Janet Auld McCann, Forty Cairndow Court, Glasgow G44 Three Thousand Pounds.

(b) To my cousin William Brown, Seventeen Greenloons Drive, Formby, Liverpool Three Thousand Pounds and in the event of the said William Brown predeceasing me I direct my Trustees to pay and make over said legacy equally among his children and the survivors and survivor of them.

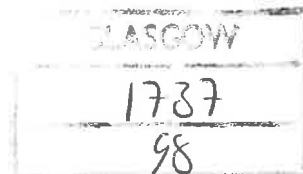
I direct my Trustees to hold and apply the residue and remainder of my means and estate and the proceeds and produce thereof as a fund to be called "The Brown Forbes Memorial Fund" in perpetuity for payment of such part of the income and such part of capital as my Trustees may in their sole discretion think fit to any suitable charitable body concerned with the preservation or reinstatement in Scotland of the natural beauty of the countryside, the coastline and any gardens or their wild life and to encourage and promote the enjoyment thereof and the involvement therein of members of the public including also the preservation or restoration of historic buildings in the ownership of a charitable organisation; Declaring always that my Trustees shall have complete discretion as to the amount of said payments and how they shall be allocated from time to time.

FIFTH

I confer on my Trustees the fullest powers, privileges and immunities conferred on gratuitous Trustees by the laws of Scotland including all those specified in the Trusts (Scotland) Acts none of which are at variance with the terms and purposes hereof. In addition the following shall apply -

- (a) My Trustees may retain all or any of the real or heritable properties and retain or renew all or any of the securities, investments and other assets of which my estate may consist at the time of my death as also to sell or otherwise realise the same in any manner which my trustees may in their uncontrolled discretion think fit and to lend out and invest my estate or any part thereof in the purchase of real or heritable property or upon real or heritable securities or upon bonds, mortgages, debentures, debenture stock, deposit receipts, preference, guaranteed, deferred or ordinary stock, shares or other securities of any company, Bank, insurance company, corporation, public trust or other and in general in and upon any securities investments and others in which a man of ordinary prudence would invest his own funds. In addition my Trustees shall have power in

their sole discretion to lend money with or without security and at such rates of interest (if any) to further the purposes of the Trust.

- (b) The apportionment acts shall not apply to this Trust.
- (c) My Trustees may appoint any of their own number or any other person to be Stockbroker, Factor, Solicitor, Banker or Accountant to the Trust and pay him or them a suitable remuneration for services so rendered.
- (d) No Trustee hereof shall be liable for anything whatever except a breach of trust knowingly and intentionally committed by such Trustee: IN WITNESS

WHEREOF these presents typewritten on this and the two preceding pages are subscribed by me at Glasgow on the Twenty fourth day of August Nineteen hundred and Ninety five before this witness Anne O'Neil Gibson (subscribing "Anne Gibson"), Bank Officer, One Thousand One Hundred and Ten Pollokshaws Road, Glasgow.
